## 1. News from the Westview Public Health: \*\*\*Updated Information\*\*\*

Grade 7 students were to be vaccinated on December 9, 2020. However, due to moving to online learning, this will obviously not happen. Westview Health Clinic will contact you once new arrangements are made for vaccines for grade 7 students.

Students in Grade 9 have received consent packages for vaccinations, if you have not yet returned your consent forms, then either send them to school with a sibling or send them directly to Westview Public Health Unit by December 11, 2020 in order for your child to receive their vaccination.

Vaccinations for Grade 9 students are scheduled for January 19, 2021.

Grade 6 students are still scheduled to receive their vaccination on December 9th, 2020 at the school.

# 8. Contract Tracing for COVID positive cases: \*\*\*Repeated Information\*\*\*

Contract tracing for positive COVID cases in schools has been typically handled by Alberta Health Services. Due to the surge in cases and personnel shortages in AHS, Parkland School Division will be handling contract tracing if there is a positive COVID case to be found in a school. Division Office and the school will be in contact with families of students if they are considered a close contact of a positive case. #### 9. Nature Kindergarten Fees: \*\*\*Repeated Information\*\*\*

Please note that as all students are moving to on-line learning for the week of January 4th to 8th, 2021, we will not be offering Nature Kindergarten programming at that time. #### 10. CAT IV (Canadian Aptitude Tests): \*\*\*New Information\*\*\*

In September, Muir Lake teachers administered CAT IV tests to all students in grades 2 to 9. The purpose of these standardized tests is to determine your child's academic growth over the past year and compare that to other Canadian students that are the same age and grade.

You will receive these results this afternoon, and we strongly encourage you to take some to read your child's results. Do remember, these test scores are a snapshot in time, and that growth is continual. Also, we had a serious disruption to learning when we moved to emergency online teaching last March.

If you have any questions regarding your child's CAT IV results please feel free to contact the front office and we can happily go over your child's test results.

Thank you for taking the time to read our weekly memo. We hope they provide the communication you need from the school to keep you informed of the happenings at Muir Lake School. As we know, good communication only enhances the school/home relationship.
