1. Registration for the 2021/2022 School Year: ***Repeated Information***

School registration for the next academic school year opened **February 8th, 2021**. It is imperative that parents register their children in order to guarantee that a dedicated spot on the bus is reserved for September 2021. Late registration does not guarantee a spot on the bus and may take up to 3 weeks to process.

Also, even if your children do not take the bus, it is important to register as these registrations determine budgets and staffing for the upcoming year. The more accurate picture we have, the easier it is for us to allocate resources to staffing, etc. Your timeliness on completing this process is both critical and appreciated. Please avoid any uncertainty and frustration by registering your child(ren) on time. Registration closes **March 25th, 2021.** An email containing a direct link to your child's registration was

sent out by our Division Office, please check for it; if it is not in your inbox then please check your Spam. You can also log into your <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal account</u> and click the 2021 2022 Registration link on the left hand side of your screen. If you have any difficulty registering or need assistance with your <u>Parent Portal account</u>, please contact the front office and we will happily assist you with the registration process.
