- 2) Principal Report Andy Surveys, measures and PATS, overall the school is doing well. Grade 4 and 7 did a survey as well as grade 9 and 10. Surveys come from the gov in Feb and March. PATs big improvements historically above provincial average and we continue to do so. Last year in June PATs in grade 6 usually there were 4 but there were just 2. Social and science only. Our average is 20-30% above the provincial average. Grade 6 science 83.6 and 68 for the province.Grade 9 above provincial average. We are hoping to improve even more. A testament to the students, parents and staff.

Oriana - education quality survey - overall satisfaction of 86.5% Parents, students, staff

Melissa - stated she is excited for UFLI - Andy stated that we bought into this program - teachers have seen a lot of improvement
